That "tombola" function may be related to locality of the pollen grains.

interesting thought if individual flowers also affect this (like size, as you mention Sami). I had spontanous mutations, or "freak flowers" ocassionally (e g a yellow flower on a normally dark orange flowering hybrid) and I've saved pollen from that freak flower to test this. It is a difficult and time consuming task to make any conclusions from this though.
